



## You can achieve so much with the education and participation package!

Every child should be able to participate. For example at baby swimming classes, in a football club or guitar class, on the next school trip or having lunch together at the daycare centre or school. This is precisely the aim of the education and participation package.

The subsidies are designed for children and young people from families who receive housing benefit, child supplement, citizen's allowance, social assistance or benefits under the Asylum Seekers' Benefits Act. Children and adolescents from birth up to a maximum age of 25 are entitled to receive the subsidy.

   (e. g. sports clubs, dance and theatre groups, music school)

#### 18 bis 25 years old

- School supplies
   (general and vocational schools)
- Excursions and trips (organised by the school)
- Lunch at the school
- Learning support (e. g. tutoring)
- Travel costs to school under certain conditions
